- What can be done for parents when their children are abusive towards them?
- What can my church or organization do to help raise awareness and prevent abuse? How can I incorporate these ideas into a sermon or Bible study?
- How can I help a teen that is cutting herself?
- How can I help build resiliency in youth that have experienced or been exposed to abuse?
